

CYO “The City” Basketball Tournament Rules 2010

Coaches

- **Only certified coaches wearing their own CYO Badge (Coaching Agreement, Background Check, ASEP & Called to Protect) may sit on the bench. If non-certified coaches are on the bench the penalty could be forfeiture of the game. Only two adult coaches and one intern coach are allowed on the bench.**
- Gatekeepers have been instructed to charge all tournament attendees who are not coaches or players.
- Please contain all team basketballs during the contest so players and fans do not bounce the balls during the games.
- **Technical Fouls or ejections received by coaches, players or spectators will be handled in the same manner as during the regular season. You must meet with the Rules & Compliance Committee prior to your next game. Since the Rules & Compliance Committee meets only during normal business hours, you could be suspended for multiple games, including the weekend.**
- Using players that are not on CYO’s Official roster will be cause for a team forfeiting the game or games.

Team Bench

- Only water will be permitted at the team bench area. No Gatorade, soda, etc.
- Teams shall clean their bench area above, below and around prior to leaving the bench area of all material and garbage including water bottles.
- Teams should take the bench immediately following the previous game.
- The lead official will determine warm up time.

Team Uniforms

- **T-Shirts worn under the uniform must all be the same color for each team.**
- **Absolutely NO ragged T-Shirts allowed (cut off sleeves, holes, etc).**

Home Team

- Team listed at the top of the game bracket is the home team.
- Home team should sit to the right of the score table (facing the score table) unless otherwise designated at the gym site.
- Home team will run the scoreboard and clock if the home facility does not supply a timekeeper.
- Will designate a parent to read the CYO pre-sport statement.

Visiting Team

- Team listed on the bottom of the bracket.
- Visiting team will sit on the left of the score table (facing the score table) unless otherwise designated at the gym site.
- Keeps the official CYO Score sheet.
- A visiting team player shall read the pre-sport prayer.

Game Rules

- **Overtimes will be 2-minute stop time with one timeout per team (30 second). No carryover of timeouts from regulation game. Each additional overtime will be 1 minute stop time with one timeout given to each team.**
- **Playing time during the CYO City Tournament is the same as the regular season. Cubs (10 minutes) Cadets (7 minutes). Failure to follow the playing time policy could be cause for forfeiture of the game.**
- **All scores must be reported immediately following your game to the CYO website at cyocamphoward.org. Go to the Score Reporting section and give game number and score. The winning team reports the score.**
